## How To Find Us

### DIRECTIONS FROM FRANKLIN:

Take Rocky Grove Avenue (Route 417) north out of Franklin through Galloway towards Dempseytown. You will make a LEFT turn onto Jesus Is The Way, exactly 1/2 mile from the intersection with Keely Road. Follow Jesus Is The Way a 1/2 mile until the road splits. Turn RIGHT and go up the hill. Signs will be posted.

### DIRECTIONS FROM OIL CITY:

Take Halyday Run Road (Route 428) out of Oil City towards Dempseytown. Turn LEFT onto Route 417 and travel 3 1/2 miles towards Franklin. You will make a RIGHT turn onto Jesus Is The Way, exactly 1/2 mile from the Bethel United Methodist Church (at the intersection with Sunville Road). Follow Jesus Is The Way a 1/2 mile until the road splits. Turn RIGHT and go up the hill. Signs will be posted.

### DIRECTIONS FROM TITUSVILLE:

Take Route 8 South to Cherrytree. Veer to the right onto Route 417 South towards Franklin. Follow this into Dempseytown. Travel 3 1/2 miles towards Franklin. You will make a RIGHT turn onto Jesus Is The Way, exactly 1/2 mile from the Bethel United Methodist Church (at the intersection with Sunville Road). Follow Jesus Is The Way a 1/2 mile until the road splits. Turn RIGHT and go up the hill. Signs will be posted.

## Live Different.

We've been told to be ourselves, to freely express who we are and what we believe, to be comfortable in our own skin. These words sound great. Who wouldn't want to confidently stand out in a crowd and be known as someone who stands by their principles? That totally sounds like what a Christian should be, right?

Truthfully, it IS what a Christian should be. But it's not something we can just put on or merely decide to do. It needs to be a FRUIT of something that God is doing in our lives. *"For it is God which works in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure"* (Philippians 2:13).

When we try to build something – whether it's a house or a character trait – we can have the best of intentions only to have things crumble at the first sign of trouble. We can decide that we're going to be strong Christians and think that's all it takes, but our will (our decisions) can only take us so far. When the storms of life come (and they will come!), the strength of what we've built will be tested, and that so-called strength will disappear. But nothing can shake or shatter what God builds in us. That work is forever!

Our hope for B.I.B.L.E. Camp this year is to focus on three steps that will help us to allow God to do mighty and everlasting things in our hearts so we can Live Different, to be seen and known as God's people.

Here are those three steps:

- No. 1 – Believe**
- No. 2 – Choose**
- No. 3 – Do**

First, we must BELIEVE what God is saying to us. Then we must CHOOSE to obey it. After that, we must DO what God says.

Seems simple, but the truth is that it takes God's hand in our lives to be able to take any and all of these steps. God wants to teach us to always ask for His help and guidance – especially when we think we don't need it!

Only when we take all three steps will we be able to "Live Different," as God has called us to do. See 1 Peter 2:9: *"But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people; that you should show forth the praises of him who has called you out of darkness into his marvelous light."*

God wants us to stand out in a crowd. He wants us to be different than the world – but not so we can boast about our confidence or our righteousness.

He wants our lives to be a reflection of Him. Only this kind of LIGHT can draw people to Christ. Many times, our lives are the only thing some people see that points them to Jesus. If you don't shine this "marvelous light," how will these people ever find the redemption and salvation they desperately need?

God has called us to be "a peculiar people" (to Live Different), so we can be sure that He has a plan to help us do this. We just need to remember that it is God who makes us different and not some sort of fortitude we can muster up that will disappear when the going gets tough. God created us so that we would need Him. Every day. Every hour. Every moment.

When the world tries to convince you that you need to stand up for yourself and declare who you are, remember that it's more important to always know WHOSE you are. Knowing that the God of Heaven holds us in His right hand ... that is where our confidence comes from so we are able to Live Different.
